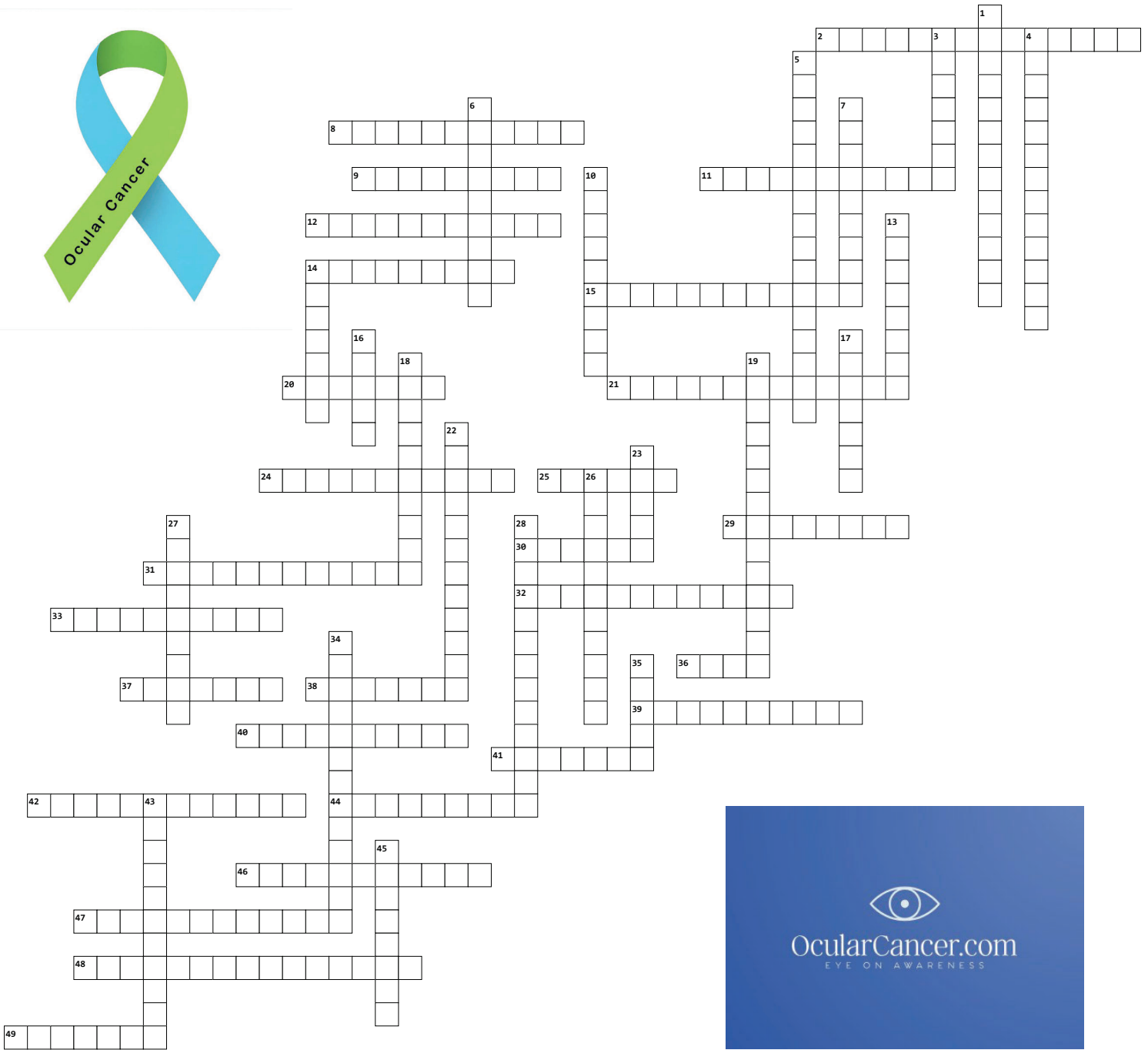


# Ocular Cancer Crossword Puzzle
